FUEL SUPPLY

NCS source products based on military grade fuel specifications. Our current supply is dominated by:

- F-34/JP8 Aviation Fuel (procured fully additised or additised in-house)
- F-35/JETA1 Aviation Fuel
- F-54/EN590 Diesel Fuel
- F-67/EN228 Unleaded Gasoline
- F-18/100LL Aviation Gasoline (AVGAS)

The procurement of fuel includes transportation, tracking, loading/unloading, and advanced logistical management. All processes adhere to the latest JIG1530 standard ensuring uncompromised fuel quality from point of manufacture to the end user.

FUEL STORAGE

NCS provides important continuity of operations planning by offering operated storage facilities. We ensure that each facility is managed and monitored by trained staff who adhere to global best practice. We are able to meet the complex requirements of our customers by delivering full scale storage solutions which include; design, construction, maintenance, and operation of permanent as well as temporary, or mobile fuel storage facilities at our costumers' location.

Installation of automated tank gauging (ATG) equipment on the storage tanks can also be provided by NCS.

DISTRIBUTION

NCS handles ground fuel retail services. By handling the entire process, we are able to deliver and distribute stable and reliable fuel supply directly to specialist units such as military vehicles, generators, and retail stations, including point of sale services. The fuel is distributed in close cooperation with the customer ensuring alignment of capabilities and operational imperatives.

NCS also offers a rapid deployable fuel distribution system, which will meet any

immidiate operational fuel supply request by allowing storage, distribution, and delivery of fuel at any location required.

FUEL TECHNICAL SERVICES

We provide customised technical services in accordance with latest international standards. These include quality assurance programs, fuel testing (full-scale up to A-level), equipment calibration, fuel training, and related HSE services.

In addition, we deliver a comprehensive Fuel Management System that automates the collection of key data enabling realtime visibility of operations.

NCS staff pay frequent visits to loading and shipping points which offsets potential supply distribution risks and help to ensure a stable fuel supply from point of manufacture to the end user.

NCS holds five ISO accreditations and certifications. Our extensive quality control procedures are embedded in a Business Management System (BMS), which is certified according to the following international standards:

Our Business Management Team ensures that all procedures in the BMS adhere to the above certifications, which include our fuel being tested throughout the supply chain by a combination of independent and in-house testing. We work closely with the World Fuel Services Global Quality Assurance and Technical Operations Organisation, who have representatives in JIG, IATA, ASTM, and other influential organisations.

FLEXIBILITY

To provide strategic agility, NCS staff are trained in accordance with international standards and our overall business model is designed and optimised for scalable solutions. This enables our highly skilled fuel professionals and logistics experts to mobilise additional delivery points in a fast and controlled manner.
